5-night driving safari in Tanzania

**LAKE MANYARA • SERENGETI • NGORONGORO**

All the lodges on this safari circuit have undergone an extensive refurbishment programme offering some of the finest safari accommodation in Tanzania. Given that all these iconic lodges command some of the best locations in their respective game parks, this itinerary certainly offers an unrivalled safari experience. This safari operates every fortnight.

Lake Manyara Hotel is located on the edge of the breathtaking escarpment of Lake Manyara National Park. All the rooms have magnificent views across the Lake. Seronera Wildlife Lodge, located in the heart of the Serengeti, is artfully constructed around a rocky outcrop, perfectly blending into the surroundings. Next to the lodge are several waterholes, attracting animals day and night. Final stop, the Ngorongoro, described as the '8th wonder of the natural world'. Your stay here is in the Ngorongoro Wildlife Lodge, perched on the rim of the crater. All the rooms offer breathtaking, uninterrupted views down into the crater floor.

## Day 1: Monday - Depart

Kenya Airways overnight flight from Heathrow via Nairobi to Kilimanjaro.

## Day 2: Tuesday - Lake Manyara

On arrival connect with your flight to Kilimanjaro. Met at Kilimanjaro International Airport and commence your safari. Drive to Lake Manyara National Park (150 kms), famous for its tree climbing lions. Arrive in time for lunch at Lake Manyara Wildlife Lodge. An afternoon game drive. Overnight: Lake Manyara Hotel. (lunch and dinner included).

## Day 3: Wednesday - Serengeti

After breakfast, drive to the Serengeti National Park (235 kms) and to the Seronera Wildlife Lodge. An afternoon game drive will reveal some of the highlights of this world-famous game reserve. Overnight: Seronera Wildlife Lodge. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

## Day 4: Thursday - Serengeti

Take an early morning balloon flight over the Serengeti followed by a 'bubbly' breakfast (optional extra £295) or an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. After lunch enjoy an afternoon game drive. Overnight: Seronera Wildlife Lodge. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

## Day 5: Friday - Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast, drive to the Ngorongoro Crater (200 kms), stopping at Olduvai Gorge. Lunch at the Ngorongoro Wildlife Lodge. Afternoon is at leisure. Overnight: Ngorongoro Wildlife Lodge. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

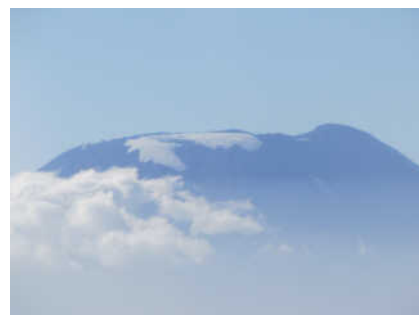
## Day 6: Saturday - Ngorongoro Crater

Descend into the crater for a half day of game viewing followed by a visit to a local Masai Village. Overnight: Ngorongoro Wildlife Lodge. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

## Day 7: Sunday - Beach or return

After breakfast return to Arusha for lunch and fly Kenya Airways overnight via Nairobi to Heathrow. (breakfast included).

**ON SAFARI IN TANZANIA**

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

**ON THE ROAD**

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.

Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.



**YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE**

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. Tanzania safaris operate using 4-wheel drive vehicles accommodating five or seven passengers, and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks.

**Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.**



All vehicles have a game viewing roof hatch. For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party.

**GAME DRIVES**

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, Although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.



**HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!**

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Serengeti. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
