13-night driving safari in Tanzania

ARUSHA • TARANGIRE • NGORONGORO • SERENGETI • LAKE VICTORIA • LAKE MANYARA

A breathtaking and extensive overland safari of Northern Tanzania, including Tarangire National Park, Lake Victoria, the animal rich plains of the Serengeti and the wonder of Ngorongoro crater, using a selection of superbly located three and four star lodges.

DAY 1: Kenya Airways overnight flight from Heathrow to Kilimanjaro via Nairobi. On arrival transfer to the Arusha Hotel for one night.

DAY 3: Morning tour of Arusha National Park visiting Ngurdoto crater & the Momella lakes followed by lunch before departing for Tarangire. Game drive en route to the Tarangire Sopa Lodge for a two night stay (approx. 99 miles) (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 4: Morning and afternoon game drives in beautiful Tarangire (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 5: En route to Ngorongoro Crater enjoy a visit to Gibbs Farm and a hike to local waterfalls. Continue to the Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge perched on the northern crater Rim with spectacular vistas and sunsets. You will spend the next two nights here (approx. 155 miles) (breakfast, lunch & dinner included).

DAY 6: Enjoy a day in and around the crater with time to visit a Masai village (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 7: Descend to the Serengeti plains and enter the National Park viewing game en route. Lunch at the Serengeti Serena Lodge and enjoy an afternoon game drive and overnight at Serena Lodge or Mbulu Mawe Tented Camp (approx. 124 miles) (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 8: Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives viewing an amazing amount of wildlife from this central location. Overnight at the Serena Lodge or Mbulu Mawe Tented Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 9: Drive through the Western Corridor of the Serengeti to Speke Bay Lodge. After lunch enjoy a guided walk and bird watch. Overnight Speke Bay Lodge (approx. 124 miles) (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 10: Take a traditional canoe ride this morning along the shore bank to a nearby village. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure or bird watch along the lake shore (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 11: Drive back into the Serengeti viewing wildlife with picnic lunch en route to the Serengeti Sopa Lodge, your base for the next two nights (approx. 155 miles) (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 12: Morning and afternoon game drives in the eastern side of the Serengeti National Park. Optional Balloon Safari today (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 13: Drive to the famous archaeological site of Olduvai Gorge and the Cradle of Mankind before continuing to Lake Manyara and the Serena Lodge (approx. 155 miles). Picnic lunch en route (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 14: Morning game drive in the beautiful Lake Manyara National Park around the lakeshore. Lunch at the Manyara Serena Lodge. In the afternoon visit a local village (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

DAY 15: Return to Arusha for lunch then to Kilimanjaro and your overnight flight to Heathrow via Nairobi.

ON SAFARI IN TANZANIA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.

Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.



GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, Although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife.

Tanzania safaris operate using 4-wheel drive vehicles accommodating five or seven passengers, and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.



All vehicles have a game viewing roof hatch. For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party.



HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Serengeti. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
