

7-night driving safari in Tanzania

ARUSHA • TARANGIRE • NGORONGORO • SERENGETI

The Manor at Ngorongoro, with its 20 luxurious guest cottage suites, is a luxury safari experience fusing East African safari hospitality with old world Afro-European architecture and décor. The Manor is located adjacent to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area within the 1500 acre Shangri-La Estate. On to the world-famous Serengeti National Park, which will include a stay at the Serengeti Migration Camp. Richly furnished throughout, the spacious tents have been carefully placed to provide privacy and blend into the natural environment, overlooking the Grumeti River and its resident hippos.

Day 1 - Depart

Fly from Heathrow on Kenya Airways overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2 - Arusha

On arrival in Nairobi connect with your flight to Kilimanjaro. Met on arrival at Kilimanjaro airport and transferred to Arusha Coffee Lodge.

Days 3 - Tarangire

After breakfast drive to Tarangire Treetops arriving in time for lunch (160 kms). After lunch travel into Tarangire National Park for a game drive. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Days 4 - Tarangire

A full day in the Tarangire National Park to enjoy morning and afternoon game drives. Optional activities such as game walks and night game drives at an extra cost. Overnight: Tarangire Treetops. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 5 - Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast drive to Lake Manyara National Park. (120 kms). Enjoy a picnic lunch and an afternoon game drive along the lake shores. Continue to The Manor at Ngorongoro in time for dinner (40 kms). (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6 - Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast drive into the Crater for a half-day visit followed by a visit to a local Masai village (time permitting). Overnight: Manor at Ngorongoro. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Days 7 - Serengeti

After breakfast drive to the Serengeti National Park for a picnic lunch. A brief stop is made at the Olduvai Gorge and museum. Continue to Serengeti Migration Camp arriving in the late afternoon with a game drive en route. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Days 8 - Serengeti

Enjoy an early morning balloon flight, followed by a 'bubbly' bush breakfast (optional extra £280), or an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. A full day in the Serengeti to enjoy game drives in this world-famous reserve. Overnight: Serengeti Migration Camp. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 9 - beach or return

After breakfast transfer to the airstrip for a scheduled flight by light aircraft to Arusha (approximately 1 hour). Met on arrival and transferred to a local restaurant for lunch. In the afternoon transfer to Kilimanjaro airport for your flight to Nairobi, then proceed with your chosen extension or return to Heathrow. (breakfast and lunch included).

ON SAFARI IN TANZANIA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.

Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.



GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, Although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife.

Tanzania safaris operate using 4-wheel drive vehicles accommodating five or seven passengers, and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.



All vehicles have a game viewing roof hatch. For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party.



HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Serengeti. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
