9-night driving / flying safari in Kenya & Tanzania

NAIROBI • MASAI MARA • LAKE VICTORIA • SERENGETI • NGORONGORO • LAKE MANYARA

A comprehensive safari across the 'icons' of East Africa, including the Masai Mara, Serengeti, Ngorongoro Crater and Lake Manyara, some of the most sought after and beautiful areas of Kenya and Tanzania.

Day 1: Depart

Kenya Airways overnight flight from Heathrow to Nairobi.

Day 2: Nairobi

On arrival transfer to the Nairobi Serena hotel in a Standard room for a day at leisure and overnight.

Day 3: Masai Mara

Fly by light aircraft to the heart of the Maasai Mara Game Reserve and the Mara Serena lodge for two nights. Enjoy an afternoon game drive in the camps' own four wheel drive vehicles and overnight (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4: Masai Mara

Thrilling morning and afternoon game drives in this game-rich central Mara location. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 5: Lake Victoria

Today drive to the Tanzania border, where you meet your vehicle to continue the journey to Lake Victoria and Speke Bay Lodge for dinner and overnight (approx. 110 miles). (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6: Serengeti

Enjoy a stunning early morning canoe safari on Lake Victoria before continuing to the vastness of the Serengeti, game viewing en route to Mbulu Mawe, a delightful Serena tented camp in the park's central region surrounded by striking boulders and grassland. Spend two nights here (approx. 95 miles). (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7: Serengeti

Soak up the Serengeti with morning and afternoon game drives. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 8: Ngorongoro Crater

This morning take your final Serengeti game drive en route whilst exiting the park, then stop at the famous archaeological site of Olduvai Gorge before arriving at the magnificent Ngorongoro Crater for two nights at the Serena Lodge (approx. 130 miles). (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 9: Ngorongoro Crater

Visit a Masai Village this morning, take lunch at the lodge in the restaurant with peerless views over the crater, then descend to the crater floor to enjoy an afternoon game drive, seeking out the plentiful big game. (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 10: Lake Manyara

Drive to Lake Manyara in the Rift Valley today, enjoying a walk and lunch in a local village before an afternoon game drive in the beautiful National Park by the lake shore. Overnight at Lake Manyara Serena (approx. 55 miles). (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 11: Beach or return

Drive to Arusha for lunch and some time to relax before transferring to Kilimanjaro airport for your Kenya Airways overnight flight via Nairobi to Heathrow. (breakfast and lunch included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.



Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. Microbuses in Kenya have game viewing hatches (accessible from the rear seats) and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.



For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party. Four wheel drive vehicles are available for a supplement on selected itineraries and seat up to five or seven passengers (all with window seats) and have game viewing roof hatches.



HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
