7-night driving safari in Kenya

ABERDARES • SAMBURU • GREAT RIFT VALLEY • MASAI MARA

A superb introduction to the splendours of Kenya, visiting a variety of key national parks and game reserves along a classic safari circuit. Accommodation in memorable locations includes an overnight stay at Treetops.

This itinerary visits the magnificent Samburu, followed by the Aberdares, Lake Nakuru and Lake Naivasha. The lakes are home to a variety of birds including numerous bright pink flamingoes. The final destination is the breathtaking Masai Mara which teems with a host of plains game plus the 'big five'.

Day 1: Sunday - Heathrow–Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2: Monday - Aberdares

On arrival transfer to the Safari Lounge, where you can freshen up and store any additional luggage before departing for Aberdares and to the Outspan Hotel (180 kms). After lunch, opportunity to relax or an afternoon nature walk with the resident naturalist (weather permitting). Dinner and overnight at the Outspan Hotel (lunch and dinner included).

Day 3: Tuesday - Samburu

Drive across the equator to Samburu National Reserve (360 km) and check in to your lodge for lunch. Afternoon game drive. Overnight: Samburu Game Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4: Wednesday - Samburu

Morning and late afternoon game drives in this open savannah which is traversed by the Ewaso Nyiro River. The river is populated by hippos and crocodiles, whilst the park is home to a host of animals including several species which are rarely seen in numbers elsewhere including Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffes and long-necked gerenuks. Overnight: Samburu Game Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 5: Thursday - Aberdares

Drive south into the Aberdare National Park (220 km) for lunch at Outspan Hotel. Transfer to Treetops (please limit your luggage to an overnight bag – the remainder can be stored at Outspan. Bathroom facilities are shared). Overnight: Treetops (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6: Friday - Lake Nakuru or Lake Naivasha

An early morning transfer to Outspan Hotel for breakfast and to collect your luggage. Descend into the Great Rift Valley and continue on to Lake Nakuru for lunch followed by an afternoon game drive. Drive to Lake Naivasha. Overnight: Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7: Saturday - Masai Mara

Drive to the Masai Mara National Reserve (320 km). An afternoon game drive. Overnight: Keekorok Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 8: Sunday - Masai Mara

Enjoy an early morning balloon flight over the Mara, followed by a 'bubbly' bush breakfast (optional extra – £275), or an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Afternoon game drive. Overnight: Keekorok Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 9: Monday - Extension or Heathrow

After breakfast, return to Nairobi (300 km), proceed with your chosen beach Extension or return to Heathrow (breakfast included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.



Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.

LIGHT AIRCRAFT FLIGHT OPTIONS



On this safari itinerary, you can cut out the final drive back to Nairobi and fly from the Masai Mara back to Nairobi, for a supplement from £190 per person. Alternatively, fly from the Masai Mara straight to Mombasa for a supplement from £265 per person.

Flights are in light aircraft and the baggage allowance is strictly 15 kg per person. Where possible additional luggage can be left at your hotel or at the Safari Lounge in Nairobi and retrieved after the safari. When flying from the Masai Mara to Mombasa your entire luggage must be restricted to 15 kg as no luggage can be stored in Nairobi.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. Microbuses in Kenya have game viewing hatches (accessible from the rear seats) and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.

For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party. Standard Microbuses are ideal for groups of 5 or more, while Premier Microbuses are more spacious. Four wheel drive vehicles are available for a supplement and seat up to five or seven passengers (all with window seats) and have game viewing roof hatches.

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
