ARNOMA HOTEL, BANGKOK

Centrally located between Siam Square and Sukhumvit, with shops, bars and restaurants on your doorstep. TOUR ITINERARY

A wonderful and comprehensive tour visiting the ancient Thailand Kingdoms of Ayutthaya and Sukhothai, the famous Bridge over the River Kwai and the fascinating scenery, temples and shopping of northern Thailand.

- DAY 1 Fly Thai Airways from Heathrow to Bangkok. Arrive the following day and spend two nights at the Majestic Grande in a Superior room.
- DAY 3 Enjoy a half day tour of the spectacular Grand Palace - the former official residence of the Kings of Thailand, and famous temple of the Emerald Buddha.
- DAY 4 Embark on a long-tail boat ride to the colourful floating market of Damnoen Saduak, then visit the spectacular Nakorn Pathom temple and Phra Pathom Chedi - the largest pagoda in Thailand, followed by the cultural Rose Garden. Drive to Kanchanaburi on the River Kwai for two nights at the Felix River Kwai Resort in a Superior garden view room (approx. 110 miles).
- DAY 5 See the famous Bridge over the River Kwai, with a journey to Wang Po on the 'death railway' included. After lunch visit the pretty Sai Yoke Waterfall, the Don Rak war cemetery and Jeath Museum, where a typical allied prisoner of war camp has been reconstructed (approx. 81 miles).
- DAY 6 Drive north, visiting a local market and house boats in the market town of Uthai Thani. Stay two nights in historical Ayutthaya at the Kantary Hotel (approx. 213 miles).
- DAY 7 Explore Ayutthaya's ruined temples, majestic palaces and handicraft stalls. Later, take a boat trip along the Chao Phraya River to the Summer Palace of Bang-Pa-In (approx. 28 miles).
- DAY 8 Travel north on a scenic train journey to Lopburi, then visit ancient Sukhothai and discover its magnificent temples, monasteries and giant Buddha statues set in beautiful surroundings of lily ponds and hillsides. Stay at the Sukhothai Heritage Resort (approx. 213 miles).
- DAY 9 Drive through tropical mountain scenery to Chiang Rai for two nights at the Phowadol Resort and Spa (approx. 250 miles).
- DAY 10 Ascend further into the mountains for an adventurous journey by 'pick-up' truck to visit an Akha Hill tribe. Enjoy lunch at Mae Sai, Thailand's most northern town on the Burmese border (approx. 135 miles).
- DAY 11 Continue to Chiang Mai. Climb the 290 steps (or use the cable car) to the famous hilltop temple, Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep, for panoramic views of Chiang Mai and the valley beyond. A traditional dinner with song and dance is optional. Spend the night at the Chiang Mai Plaza Hotel in a Standard room (approx. 114 miles).
- DAY 12 Complete your experience with a visit to an elephant camp (approx. 32 miles), then fly Thai Airways to Bangkok and transfer to Pattaya, for a four night stay at the Cosy Beach Hotel.
- DAY 16 Return to Bangkok airport for your return flight to the UK.
